Sunbeams - Using your original image, we simply added the idea of a vibrant sun and played with the text position.

Colourwork - A play on the fields and sky landscape idea with unnaturalistic colours, very vibrant. Landscape can obviously be adjusted but we like the contrast colours and text is more subtle and again could be refined.

NatureDesign - With this one we were thinking you could propose elements that are specifically linked with Maids Moreton and the community; eg the church, birds or sheep from scott's lane. Make text the central focal point and design a naturalistic creative border of imagery and colour.

SportDesign - incorporating and highlighting the different sport facilities that bring people together, alongside nature and weather elements, vibrant block colours, fun use of shapes that appeal to all.
