Cricket Club Shed Proposal

We have recently purchased a new roller to replace our old one which was becoming increasingly harder to start. Although the two are identical the newer one is in much better condition but has been stored in a garage it's whole life.

We would like to take a bit more care of the new roller and therefore think having a weatherproof shelter to store it would help significantly. We are currently throwing a tarpaulin sheet over it to protect it from the rain, however this isn't sufficient in the winter months.

What we would like to propose is to build a fully enclosed shed off of the left-hand side of our container, using the container as one side of the structure.

We would like to put in a couple of uprights similar to the front of the pavilion and then bolt a roof to the top of those and the container. We would then enclose it using fence panels and a locked gate on the front.

We would build it to the same height as the container to prevent it from being climbed on. We would also be happy to paint it with anti-climb paint if there's any of this still around from when the pavilion roof was last done.

The only thing that would be kept in the shed would be the roller purely for protection from the elements. We would keep on top of any vandalism and damages. The last thing we want to be doing is creating a hide out for the youths that want to hang around down there.
